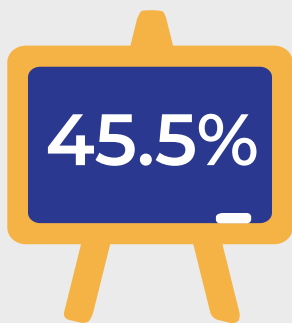




OUR YEAR IN NUMBERS



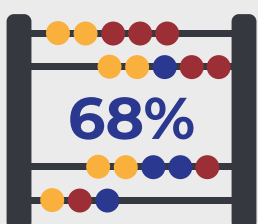
Catherine McAuley School in 2023 was **above the national average** for NAPLAN in 3 areas for **Year 3: Writing, Spelling, Grammar**

RECEPTION STUDENTS on average improved their **Foundations of Early Literacy Skills** by 302% from Term 1 to Term 3

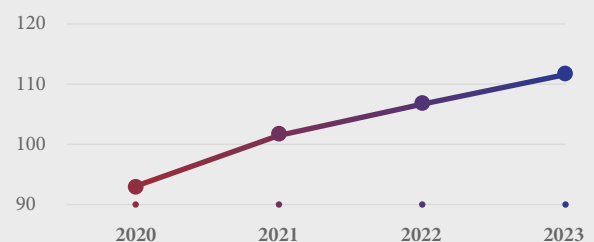


of our **YEAR 2-6 STUDENTS** improved by **3 or more points** in their scale scores in PAT Mathematics testing

RECEPTION

We improved our word-reading fluency by an average of **11 more words per minute**

↑ **900%**

YEAR 1

We improved our oral-reading fluency by an average of **41 more words per minute**

↑ **970%**

YEAR 2

We improved our oral-reading fluency by an average of **51 more words per minute**

↑ **350%**

YEAR 3

We improved our oral-reading fluency by an average of **47 more words per minute**

↑ **101%**

YEAR 4

We improved our oral-reading fluency by an average of **51 more words per minute**

↑ **87%**

YEAR 5

We improved our oral-reading fluency by an average of **38 more words per minute**

↑ **42%**

YEAR 6

We improved our oral-reading fluency by an average of **36 more words per minute**

↑ **35%**

Our younger year levels start at a much lower point than our older year levels, and so the percentage increase starts to naturally decrease as they become more proficient readers.
